



ACEnet Resource Allocation Committee

Scope

ACEnet's Resource Allocation Committee (RAC) has responsibility for the allocation of:

- Computer Resources
- Storage Resources
- Allocation of Technical Support (in conjunction with the CTO)

Mandate

The RAC will ensure that ACEnet's overall resources are directed towards furthering ACEnet's goals of strengthening HPC based Research in Atlantic Canada.

The RAC will establish and review ACEnet's standard allocations (fairshare, disk quotas etc.) and may, from time to time, make changes to these as required.

The RAC will accept proposals from Researchers who need a larger share of the available resources than is provided by the established standards. By evaluating the merit of the research project and also evaluating the impact of such a change on the overall ACEnet user community, the RAC will respond to such proposals.

The RAC will work with the National Resource Allocation Committee (NRAC) to accommodate national strategies as appropriate.

Membership

There will be eight voting members from participating ACEnet institutions, but no two members may originate from the same institution.

A Research Directorate representative and the ACEnet CTO will be non-voting members.

A Chair for the RAC is chosen from the eight voting members.

The RAC is expected to meet not less than three times a year.
